GroupDrive 5.0 adds support for the company's DMZedge Server which reduces the risk of network intrusion. The DMZedge sits outside the corporate firewall and enables inbound communication ports to be closed. No files or documents are stored outside of the firewall, and all communication occurs on an outbound communication channel opened by the GroupDrive Server. Used in conjunction with the existing Secure Sockets Layer protocol in GroupDrive, as well as encrypting the stored files, users have complete end-to-end security for collaborating on sensitive or proprietary documents.

Other security enhancements include the complex passwords feature to reduce the risk of password cracking, allowing administrators to set a policy requiring certain password attributes such as special characters, inclusion of numbers or a minimum number of characters. An anti-hammering capability adds an additional layer of security to prevent hackers from crashing a corporate server by 'hammering' it with hundreds or thousands of requests a second from the same IP address. In addition to the added security features, GroupDrive 5.0 includes enhanced notification features, enabling users to receive notifications for events such as new content being added to a folder or updates being posted for specified documents.

"Companies often move to a Basic Content Services solution to improve efficiency, reduce the load on email servers and enable auditing, but security is often an afterthought," said Michael Ryan, CEO and co-founder of South River Technologies, Inc. "GroupDrive effectively integrates the need for easy file access and collaboration while considering the requirements for both secure transmission and enhanced network security."

The Basic Content Service market emerged several years ago as businesses and organizations of all sizes began embracing collaborative document management offerings such as GroupDrive that were cost effective and easier to install and manage than enterprise content management solutions.
